Accessibility

Limited accessible spaces are available in Car A on the Tilt Train, as well as signage with raised text, braille and hearing aid loops.

An accessible toilet is located in Car A.

Most types of mobility devices can be accommodated on the Tilt, however size restrictions do apply.

In general, these dimension limits are 680 mm wide by 1200 mm long on the Tilt Train.



The Galley

The Galley is located in Car B and Car E and stocks a wide variety of hot food and snacks. Grab a cup of coffee or just a quick bite to go. The Galley service is in addition to the hand trolley service[^].



Business

Travelling in Business seats includes a larger seat, juice and newspaper when onboard and blankets available on request. All seats have a 240v powerpoint to power your electronics.



Economy

Enjoy generous recline, a fold down table and foot rest and onboard entertainment provided by the overhead screens. All seats face the direction of travel. USB charging port under the arm rest of each seat for phones and tablets.



Train 101

The Tilt Train fleet carries over 180 thousand passengers a year between Brisbane, Bundaberg and Rockhampton. Travelling at up to 160km per hour, these are some of the fastest trains in Australia.
